| LLRRWMC employees have the right to refuse any material they deem as spoiled or non-salvageable | |
| Crushed rock or concrete accepted for site maintenance (must be approved by manager) | Cardboard, tin cans and plastics (#1-#7) All plastics must have a recycle symbol. (Paper, mixed fibre and clean clothing is only accepted at the Recycle Depot). |
| Reusable lumber | Wet Cell Batteries |
| Reusable household items in clean/working condition (ie. Childrens toys, kitchen items, books, artwork/decor, electronics, etc.) | Clean soil accepted for cover material (must be approved by manager) |
| Reusable construction items in good condition (ie. Doors, windows, furniture, etc.) | Propane tanks 1-100lbs with valve stems (1lb tanks must have a label) |
| Salvageable metal & bikes (ie. Bike parts, tin roofing, rebar, copper pipe or insulated wire) | Salvageable equipment parts & small tools/appliances |

| Household Hazardous Waste (ie. Pesticides, cleaning products, pool/hottub chemicals, etc.) | Only collected 1-week/year at the La Ronge Recycle Depot (watch for details on HHW Collection Events or Roundups happening in the tri-community) |
| Industrial Hazardous Waste (ie. Paint or construction products in large quantities or with industrial labels) | Please contact Green for Life or Protex Environmental |
| Animal carcasses from out of region | Please present your provincial tag and ID at the gate |

Other Important Information:

- Demolition permits are required to be presented at the gate for any building demos. Please contact your local municipality.
- LLRRWMC has zero tolerance towards harassment or verbal abuse of our employees. All questions, concerns, complaints can be addressed to the Manager at llrrwmcmanager@gmail.com.
- Smoking is prohibited onsite. Customers will only receive ONE verbal warning before being suspended from entering the landfill and/or fined.
- The Landfill and Recycle Depot are industrial work sites. All public customers enter at their own risk, must always be aware of heavy equipment, wear appropriate clothing and footwear, follow all rules and road signs, and always have complete control and responsibility over their pets and children.
- Unlawful dumping will be reported to authorities and charges will be made.
- The fee schedule will be reviewed annually and subject to change at any time.
- All loads coming into the landfill must be tied down and contained
